Book Bank Book Sorter

Book Bank Sorters will sort new and gently used children's books, preparing them to go to our community partners who distribute them to families who have few or no books of their own.

Talents needed: Love of reading, organizational skills and knowledge of books. Time commitment: 2 hours weekly or bi-weekly.



House Host at Little Red Reading House

House Hosts help encourage the joy of reading, help children and families access books, promote literacy and help enhance parent-child connection through reading.

Talents needed: Experience working with children, Strong reading skills, fluent and articulate in English, patient and reliable, love of reading, ability to read with children with diverse backgrounds and a current Alberta Police Clearance with a volunteer sector check.

Time commitment: 2 hours weekly or bi-weekly. An interview will be conducted to assess suitability for this position.



Community Book Droppers

Community Book Droppers will come to our Book Bank to pack and pick up Ziplock bags filled with books and extras. It will take about 1/2 hour for book prep. Volunteers will then go out into high-needs communities to drop the bags in parks, on bus benches, train stations and places where you think families will find the books. Ideal for corporate or community groups.

Talents needed: Love of reading, time, map reading skills. Time commitment: 2 hours when book drops are scheduled.

Little Free Library Stockers

Little Free Library Stockers pick up book bags from our Little Red Reading House in Inglewood and fill up Little Free Libraries in community. This opportunity is a great way to get to know your community and help provide books to Calgarians. **Talents needed:** Love of books and time. **Time commitment:** 2 hours – anytime.

Book Runners give back to community by delivering books to our community partners who distribute them to families who have few or no books of their own. **Talents needed:** Strength for lifting and carrying, a car, good map reading skills and a big heart.

Time commitment: 2 hours once or twice a month as needed
